Rules of Event

All entries must meet the following criteria:

- i.** Author Status: Shall be an undergraduate, graduate student, faculty, advocate or a Legal Scholar.
- ii.** Co-authorship: Co- authorship of one person is allowed.
- iii.** Single Submission: No participants shall be allowed to submit more than one paper; only one paper will be accepted by an author, either as a sole author or as a co-author.
- iv.** Originality: Each paper must be an original analysis and must be the author's own work. Papers previously published are not eligible.

Title Page and Abstract

- v.** The title page must include the author's name, faculty advisor's name, institutional affiliation, expected degree (or recently received degree) and graduation Date (month/year) and email address.
- vi.** An abstract of not more than 300 words must follow the title page. Title and abstract pages are separate and would not be counted within the stipulated number given in sub-headA.
- vii.** Page headers and/or footers should contain page numbers and a shortened title of the paper. Participants shall ensure that the header or footer must not include the author's name or the name of his or her institution, to shield incognito review by the judges.



PAPER PREPARATION GUIDELINES

Main Body:

1. The paper must be written in English.
2. Font Type- Times New Roman
3. Font Size -12
4. Margins of 1 inch (2.5 cm) all around
5. Double space
6. Papers shall only be submitted in MS Word (doc. or docx) **and** Adobe Acrobat (pdf) format.

Footnotes:

1. Font Type - Times New Roman
2. Font Size - 10 pts.
3. Line Spacing - 1.0
4. Footnoting shall follow 19th edition Blue book.
5. No endnotes or speaking footnotes are allowed.
6. Only 20 % Plagiarism is permitted.

Registration

1. Academicians/ lawyers/scholars: Rs. 1,000/- for single author and for Co- Author, Rs. 700/-.
2. Students: Rs. 700/- for single author and for Co- Author, then Rs. 600/-.
3. For Accommodation, participants have to pay Rs. 700/- extra. {can be availed on request}
4. The teams must register online by **clicking here**
5. Submission shall be made at **conference@lloydcollege.edu.in**
6. The amount is to be paid by the participants whose abstracts are selected. The result of abstract selection round will be released on 21/01/2020. The selected participants must register by 27/01/2020. Only the participants who will complete the final registration will be allowed to present their papers and only those papers will be considered for publication
