ABOUT EVENT

The National Parliamentary Debate 2020 is scheduled from 29th to 31st March, 2020. The Parliamentary Debating Society of School of Law and Governance, CUSB, aims at moulding well informed and aware citizens of the country and embark the culture of debate and room for disclosures, dissent, and discussion among the student community. Parliamentary debate is the integral part of Law School which develops and enhances the communication skills, advocacy skills, reasoning ability among the students.

The debate consists of two teams, one will be from the government side and the other from opposition. Both the teams comprise of three members each. The government includes Prime Minister, Deputy Prime Minister and the Government Whip and the Opposition includes Leader of Opposition, Deputy Leader of Opposition and Opposition Whip. Each Member of the team gets 7 minutes to speak and put their arguments before the house so as to either pass the motion or oppose the motion. Adjudicator evaluates them on the basis of



arguments and gives decision either in the favour of government or opposition and thus the bill is either passed or opposed. In this format the best speaker, the best adjudicator, the winning team and the runner up team are awarded.

Through this competition students will inculcate new ideas, thought process, and exchange the debating culture of different varsities and will also motivate the students of our university to participate in different National and International events.

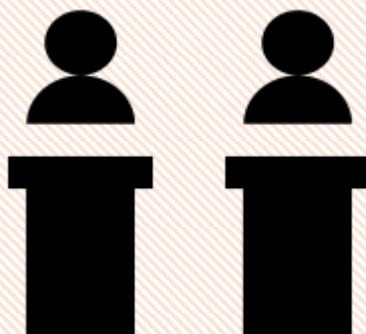


TEAM COMPOSITION
