On successful completion of the Theoretical Learning Module, Fellows will be deputed to senior political leaders, where they will be guided to

- Providing inputs for bills under discussion, parliamentary questions and general policy discussions
- Providing background research for conferences, speeches etc
- Policy Formulation
- Social media and communications management
- Political campaign management
- Liaising with other consultants from across the industry

Candidates will be admitted over three rounds-

Questionnaire round- Where the applicant is expected to answer a series of questions on policy and political issues in an essay format.

Personal interview round- A remote interview with the management committee.
