

1.	New Year Day	1	01/01/2025	Wednesday	1. All the Sundays are declared holidays for the High Court and Registry including the Sundays falling during Summer Vacation & Winter Holidays.
2.	Mahashivratri	1	26/02/2025	Wednesday	2. Second & Third Saturdays of the month shall be closed Saturdays for the High Court and Registry.
3.	Holi Holidays	2	13/03/2025 to 14/03/2025	Thursday to Friday	3. The remaining Saturdays which are not declared holidays and which are not included in Summer Vacation and winter holidays are declared non working Saturdays for the High Court but Registry shall remain open on these Saturdays.
4.	Id-UI-Fitr	1	31/03/2025	Monday	4. Republic Day, Ram Navami & Muharram, falls on Sundays, Raksha Bandhan & Janamashtami falls on non working Saturdays, and Gandhi Jayanti & Dasherha falls on same day therefore, no Holiday is declared separately.
5.	Mahaveer Jayanti	1	10/04/2025	Thursday	5. The High Court shall remain closed from 12.05.2025 to 06.06.2025 on account of Summer Vacation but the Registry shall remain open during Summer Vacation.

7.	Good Friday	1	18/04/2025	Friday	7. Holidays declared on account of Milad-Un-Nabi, Id-UI-Fitr, Id-UI-Juha and Muharram are subject to change depending upon the visibility of the Moon. If the State Government declares any change in these dates through TV/AIR/Newspaper, the same will be followed and that day will also be observed as holiday with the approval of Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
