

“Eradicate Corruption- Build a New India”

RULE BOOK

1.1. Administration

(a) The LLOYD LAW COLLEGE National Debate – 2018 (“Competition”) is held and administered by Lloyd law college Greater Noida.

(b) The competition will be held on 1st November 2018 at main Campus, Lloyd law college Greater Noida campus.

1.2. Language

The competition will be conducted in English and Hindi both.

1.3. Eligibility

The competition is open for students pursuing any Undergraduate degree courses or Postgraduate degree courses in any recognized University/College.

1.4. Composition and Structure

The competition is for individual participation and will be judged on individual basis.

Each participant shall have 3 minutes (5 minutes in case of elocution) to put forward their opinion and content.

30 seconds extra time will be provided if needed. (Subject to Discretion of Judges)

1.5. Registration format

Teams must register by 29 **October 2018** and mailed scan copy of the registration form should be send at constitutionclub@lloydlawcollege.edu.in before 11:59 P.M.

1.6. Scouting

- (a) Teams shall not be allowed to observe the oral rounds of other teams, unless they have been officially knocked-out of the competition. Scouting is strictly prohibited.
- (b) Scouting by any team shall result in disqualification.

1.7. Awards

The Winning will receive a trophy and cash prize worth Rs. 5,000/-.

The Runners-Up will receive a cash prize worth Rs. 3,000/-.

Second Runner-Up will receive a cash prize worth Rs. 2,000/-.

1.8 Marking Criteria

Marks will be provided on the following spaces and it is expected to the speakers to follow the same:

Content	40 marks
Language	20 marks
Ability to response questions	20 marks
Poise	10 marks
Time management	10 marks

1.8. The decision of the judges shall be final and binding.

1.9. Accommodation, food and transportation

- (a) Participants shall arrange their own accommodation and transportation, should any assistance be required, feel free to contact the organizers.
- (b) Participants may make use of the bus services plying from Delhi to central campus.
- (c) High tea will be provided to all participants on the date of competition.
