Specific Instructions to Authors and Contributors

Elenchus Law Review concentrates on original research work extending across inter-disciplinary subjects. Authors, reviewers and editors are under the obligation to follow the specific rules provided by the Centre for Economy, Development and Law. This document contains the instructions to author(s) as mentioned in the title.

What the authors should do:

- Ensure the originality of the research work submitted. The work has
 to be fully referenced, and all authors should be accurately
 represented. Kindly get acknowledgement letters from co-authors
 before the submission.
- 2. The submission must be exclusive. It must not be published anywhere else, all, or in part. In case of submission anywhere else, the author should intimate the editor clearly on this.
- 3. Disclose sources of all data and third party material, including previous unpublished work by authors themselves.
- 4. Strictly avoid fabrication of research data as well as manipulation of existing data.
- 5. Openly declare any conflicts of interest for example, if the research work was intended to benefit any particular service or institute in which the author's interest lies. If the submitted work contains a significant conceptual or textual re-production of the research work undertaken by/for such institution, then kindly submit acknowledgement letter from the relevant authority.
- 6. Expect accurate plagiarism checking measures. Submissions will be scrutinized for plagiarism of words, ideas, writings, information, illustration, graphic representations, printed and electronic materials, and any other original work. Correct citation is essential.
- 7. Do proper referencing in the submission by strictly following the recommended citation style. At any stage of the editorial/review process, author(s) will be directed to undertake this themselves if the submission has not used proper referencing styles.
- 8. Maintain good communication and co-operate fully with the editorial team. Publishing at *Elenchus* usually takes a six-months' process from last date of submissions to the hard copy release. Kindly be considerate that serious academic publication requires a minimum of this much time.
