***The first committee is the UNGA DISEC - agenda being "Prevention of Arms Race in Outer Space with Special Emphasis on the Policy of No First Placement of Weapons in Outer Space."***

On 2 December 2014, the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) adopted with a vote of 126 in favor, 4 against and 46 abstentions, Resolution 69/32 entitled 'No first placement of weapons in space. . First, it indicates the growing recognition of the positive role that transparency and confidence-building measures play in preventing an arms race in space (PAROS), even from the perspective of those States that has suggested the adoption of a treaty on PAROS, namely China and Russia. Second, it shows the willingness of a crescent number of members of the United Nations General Assembly to engage in initiatives aimed at promoting a more secure space environment. Third, its controversial reception proves that a universal solution to the issue of space security still lays far ahead. Delegates are expected to discuss important developments in space security and analyse the contribution of Resolution 69/32.

**The second committee is the All India Political Party Meet'19 (AIPPM) – agenda being “Review of the NDA Performance with special emphasis on Upcoming General Election (Lok Sabha)'19.”**

With the upcoming general elections, the agenda is a perfect opportunity for students to become more conscious about the current political atmosphere and analyse the current government's strength and weakness, provide alternatives and solution to the hindrances in the present governance.
