All Sundays and second Saturdays have been shown in red colour. Local holidays i.e. $3^{\text {rd }} \& 4^{\text {th }} \mathrm{Jan}, 22^{\text {nd }} \& 23^{\text {rd }}$ Mar, $18^{\text {th }}$ Apr, $16^{\text {th }}$ Aug, $9^{\text {th }}$ Sept, $3^{\text {rd }}, 4^{\text {th }} \& 25^{\text {th }}$ Oct, $11^{\text {th }}$ Nov will be observed exclusively by the High Court. $2^{\text {nd }}$ Jan, $1^{\text {st }}$ Mar, $5^{\text {th }}, 7^{\text {th }} \& 26^{\text {th }}$ Oct will be observed as Local Holidays by the High Court and the Courts Subordinate to it.
The High Court will remain closed for Summer Vacation from Saturday, $1^{\text {st }}$ June to Saturday, $29^{\text {th }}$ June (both days inclusive) and for Winter Vacation from Thursday, $26^{\text {th }}$ December to Tuesday, $31^{\text {st }}$ December (both days inclusive).
The Subordinate Courts (except the Courts of Metropolitan Magistrates) in Delhi will remain closed for Summer Vacation from Monday, $10^{\text {th }}$ June to Saturday, $29^{\text {th }}$ June (both days inclusive) and for Winter Vacation from Thursday, $26^{\text {th }}$ December to Tuesday, $31^{\text {st }}$ December (both days inclusive).
