RULE BOOK

1. REGISTRATION

- 1.1 The participants must register themselves by filling the online form.
- 1.2 Registrations can be done simultaneously with the submission, but not later than the last date of submission, in any case.
- 1.3 The link for the registration form is: registration link click here.
- 2. **REGISTRATION FEE:** There is **no** registration fee for the competition.
- 3. **ELIGIBILITY:** The competition is open to all the students pursuing LL.B. (3 year or 5 year course) or LL.M. from any recognized university across India.
- 4. **TOPIC:** The fiction should be related to Law. The piece must be written in short story telling style and woven around legal scenario/plot/ subject.

5. AUTHORSHIP

- 2 Only one fiction per participant is permitted.
 - 5.2 Co-authorship up to two students is permitted. However, the same shall be considered as single participation only.
 - 5.3 The Co-authors may belong to same or different institutions.

6. PRIZES AND CERTIFICATES

The prizes for the competition are as follows:

- i. 1st Prize: 7,000 INR and Certificate of Merit.
- ii. 2nd Prize: 5,000 INR and Certificate of Merit.
- iii. 3rd Prize: 3,000 INR and Certificate of Merit.

Certificate of participation will be given to all the participants.

7. **IMPORTANT DATE**

6 The last date for submission for legal fiction is 31st December, 2018.
7.2 No submissions will be accepted after 11:59 pm of the above mentioned date.

8 SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- 8.1 The language of the legal fiction should be English only.
- 8.2 The participants must send their submissions through the following link only: submission link click here
- 8.3 The submissions must be original. No part of it should have been published earlier nor should it be under the consideration for publication or a contest elsewhere. Plagiarism of any sort will result in immediate disqualification.
- 8.4 The word limit per submission is 5,000 -7,000 words.
- 8.5 UPES reserves all the rights related to the fiction.
- **9. FORMATTING GUIDELINES:** All submissions must be typed and adhere to the following requirements:

Font Type: Times New Roman;

Font size: 12;

Line Spacing: 1.5;

Alignment: Justified;

Margin: 1' on all sides.
